


City Haul – Fall 2009

By the Numbers:

The popularity of this event when first held has not been matched. However, attendance and tonnages have remained very consistent over the past two years.



Trash and Junk – The numbers remained fairly consistent between this falls event and last spring. There was only a four ton difference between the two events.



Electronics – The electronics recycling remains very popular. In the one weekend we were able to fill a truck trailer with roughly 15 boxes and pallets full of computers, TVs, DVD players and various other electronic gadgets.
