

Acceptable Materials

Electronics Recycling: Old computer equipment, cell phones, TVs, anything with a cord.

Yard Waste: Limbs no longer than 4 feet and no larger than 6 inches in diameter. Wood chipper on site - free mulch may be available. First come - first served. Load your own truck.

Trash: Household waste, junk.

Flourescents & Batteries: tubes, bulbs & household batteries

What's NOT Allowed: Tires, appliances, wet paint (dried paint is OK), toxic or hazardous materials, commercial waste. (Some items may be taken to the County Landfill)

CITY TO BEGIN MERCURY RECYCLING PROGRAM

Starting with this Fall's City Haul, the city will begin accepting items containing mercury for recycling at the City Hall Annex Building in addition to regular household batteries.

Accepted Materials:

- 4 & 8ft flourescent tubes
- round flourescent bulbs
- CFLs
